The definition of dummy or an inert weapons accepted by the Royal Malaysian Police is as follows:-

Any item or armament or any projectile which contains no explosives or incendiary material and which has been rendered inert to a degree from which it can never be repaired to become a usable weapon or projectile in weapons.

DECLARATION

We understand that this is a condition of the Licensing Authority for LIMA 2007 Maritime, no weapon, ammunition or explosive will be exhibited other than dummies, inert ammunition and weapons, which have been rendered irreversibly unserviceable and confirm that all our exhibits comply with this rule. The list of items, which could be described as weapons, whether actual, model, cut away or inert, is down on the reverse of the form.

Within the consignment of exhibits and materials shipped to Langkawi by us for display at LIMA 2007 Maritime are the following items, which under the definition stated on the reverse of this form can be classified as "weapons".
